I was born in Madrid in 1967. Graduated in **Quantum Chemistry**, I studied Mathematics and a doctoral thesis in **Artificial Intelligence**. I worked for 10 years employed in technology and financial companies as computer systems and networks and Internet **security technical consultant**.

Since August 1999, I recognize myself as a writer, specifically a poet.

In 1996, I began training as an **actor** focusing into stage and body languages, theatrical improvisation, vocal and body expression, contemporary dance and Argentine Tango until 2015.

From 1997 to 2003 I attended **poetry workshops and Creativity Development courses** (Editorial Grupo Cero, Editorial Fuentetaja, Community of Madrid). I staged my own stories, participated and continue to participate in **poetry recitals and venues**, as well as coordinating various poetic-stage shows.

I have written up to now more than 20 books of tales, code poetry and contemporary poems.

Between 2002 and 2003 and from 2007 to 2009, I was a film commentator on the Estrenos radio program (Radio Intercontinental in Madrid) and a **film critic** (La Netro Magazine), participating in colloquia and cineforums.

During 2002 I inaugurated the space La Cava de Humilladero, Madrid, in which developed new projects, in the line of research in **visual**, **objectual** and **stage poetics**, happenings, etc. Since 2004, I have been making works that could be considered visual, performances or 4D poems in different places inside and outside Spain.

In 2003 I started working on the **Lejanías project**, **interactive book-CD**, in Javascript/HTML format (lejanias.giusseppe.net), which combines computing and poetry, video, photography and performance. It was presented with a performance exhibition at Espacio El Manantial, Madrid, 2010.

In 2011 I inaugurate a blog in which I write daily poems, confidences and opinions on current issues and other areas of culture that fall into my scope of interests.

Since 2011 I have been working on a **Project for the Phylogenetic Organization of the Languages of the World** (lenguas.giusseppe.net), carrying out a work of systematic classification and typification of the various languages on the planet. As a result of this, in 2017 I published the book **Fuyu-Han Languages** as a proposal for a phylogenetic classification, considered one of the branches of the macrofamily of Altaic languages. Since 2015 I am **Collaborator of the UNESCO Chair** of Linguistic Technologies (www.teclin.org) at the Polytechnic University of Madrid.

Throughout 2013 I carried out an investigation to **reformat Ludwig Wittgenstein's Tractatus** Logico-Philosophicus to adapt it to a mind map format that concluded with a 12-hours durational performance. Between 2015 and 2016 I worked on the **conceptual art project La Consulta: Caso 30** as a proposal of

Jaime Vallaure, Teresa del Pozo and Rafael Suárez. It materialized in a multimedia book that summarized the work carried out including text, photographs and video-performances.

I had the honor of working as assistant in the **Personal Dictionary of Isidoro Valcárcel Medina**, funding by the Museum of Contemporary Art of Barcelona (MACBA) during 2015.

In 2016, I inaugurated a professional section called *literary cabinet* (*literary coaching*), carrying out independent publishing work on poetry books until I open, in 2023, the **publishing house "Clave 53 Edita"** (clave53.org/edita).

I have edited several **Code-Poetry** books made in various formats and different programming languages (BASIC, C, Javascript, Python...). After more than 20 years participating in national and international **mail art** calls, it is since 2017 that I begin a more exhaustive production.

I currently manage the Clave 53 Cultural Association (www.clave53.org), together with Carmen de la Rosa. Since 2003, apart from the work of coordinating exhibitions and intensive courses or seminars that are carried out at the Clave53 Cultural Association, I have given workshops on creativity, performance art, experimental writing and poetry, and I have given lectures on different fields such as contemporary art, poetry, philosophy, science or technology (computer security).
